- Age 65+ and earned \$33,800 or under in 2022?
- Disabled and earned \$33,800 or under in 2022?
- A disabled veteran?
- A surviving spouse of a service member or veteran?

Then you could be eligible for property tax relief and get money back in your pocket!

Then you could be eligible for property tax relief and get money back in your pocket! North Carolina's Elderly or Disabled Exclusion program provides property tax relief for qualifying homeowners at least 65 years of age or those totally and permanently disabled. The Disabled Veteran Exclusion program has no age or income limitation and provides relief specifically for disabled veterans, and the surviving spouses (who have not remarried) of servicemembers or veterans.

AARP Foundation Property Tax-Aide offers a free service for getting property tax relief in your community.

You could save money and get help staying in your home during these tough times.

A trained volunteer can determine if you meet eligibility requirements and help you apply.
